

For this assignment, you will create one complete HTML web page based on the HTML tags, elements, and features we studied in class. I will also share a Word document that contains the HTML tags and topics covered in our lessons. Your main task is to build a page that uses as many of those tags and features as possible in a meaningful and organized way.

You may choose one of the following approaches:

Create a page titled "My Academic Profile and Course Registration Page"

Create a page about a movie archive

Create a page about cars

Or create a page on another topic of your choice

The topic is flexible, but the most important requirement is that your page should demonstrate that you can use the HTML structures and features included in the Word document.

Important Rule:

Your page must be written as a single HTML file.

If you use CSS, it must be written inside the same HTML file using the <style> tag.

Do not use a separate external CSS file.

Requirements

Your web page should include, where appropriate, the HTML elements and features we studied, such as:

basic document structure

headings and paragraphs

comments

line breaks and horizontal rules

text formatting tags

links

images

lists

tables

forms

labels and input elements

internal CSS

page organization elements

You are expected to use the tags and properties from the Word document in a logical and readable way. Do not just place tags randomly. Build a page that has a clear structure and meaningful content.

Content Choice

You may prepare your page in one of these styles:

a personal academic page

a registration/contact page

a movie collection/archive page

a car introduction/comparison page

a technology, sports, travel, music, or hobby page

any other original theme

So, the topic is your choice, but the HTML coverage is compulsory.

What I Expect to See

Your page should show that you can:

build a complete HTML document correctly

organize content with headings and sections

use different text elements properly

create links and navigation

insert images

create ordered and unordered lists

build at least one table

build at least one form

apply CSS inside the HTML file

use the tags from the Word document as completely as possible

Submission Rules

Submit one .html file

The file must open and run correctly in a browser

All CSS must be inside the same file

Your work must be your own

The page should be neat, readable, and well organized

Evaluation Criteria

Your assignment will be evaluated based on:

correct HTML structure

correct and meaningful use of tags

inclusion of the topics covered in the Word document

organization and readability

correct use of tables and forms

correct use of internal CSS

overall effort and completeness

Final Note

You are free to be creative with the topic and design. However, creativity alone is not enough. The main purpose of this assignment is to show that you can apply the HTML elements and features we studied in class.

Choose a topic you like, but make sure your page includes the HTML content from the provided Word document as fully as possible.
